The School began in 2005 with six students and has since grown to over ten. These students live with Mr. and Mrs. Blair, yet their hope is to expand the School to house as many as fifty boys, and the current accommodations cannot accommodate such a large number. Recently, the West End School suffered a fairly serious setback when much of its main building suffered heavy water damage as a result of flooding. For this reason, as well as continuing support for Pastor Awkard and Mr. Blair's vision for the School, FSAB feels that the West End School is a very deserving and needing source of charity for this year's FSAB Charity Golf Scramble.***
